For 48 years, CCP has occupied Tibet. There has been over 17 percent of the Tibetan people killed, and 6,000 monasteries destroyed. The genocide continues with the murder of at least two Tibetans by Chinese border patrols.

Doris Chen’s mother, a Hong Kong Falun Gong practitioner has been detained in Shanghai for nearly 6 months. No family member has seen or talked to her since her arrest. It is said she once went on a hunger strike in the detention centre. Her case was raised during this year’s Australian Chinese human rights dialogue.

Christianity is tightly controlled by Chinese Communist authorities. Churches not officially registered with the CCP are seen as illegal entities and are still being persecuted into the 21st century.

In her book "Witnessing History," published in Taiwan, Australia, US and Europe, Jennifer Zeng tells a moving story of her harassment, arrest and detention by the Chinese Communist Party and her ultimate move to Australia due to her practice of Falun Gong.
